- Intel can be outdated by the time you receive it.

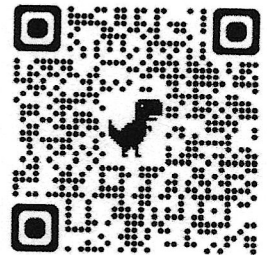
**What is Open Source Intelligence?** A broad array of information & sources that are generally available without special privileges.
